President's Message



Hello Idaho Pitchers. We just returned from Wausau, Wisconsin from the 2026 World Horseshoe tournament. It was a great venue to set up at the Greenheck-Turner Community Center. We are looking forward to going back in 2029. I

ended with an 11-4 record, and took 3rd place in Men's Q. I had a great time!

I was voted back in as NHPA Sec-Treasurer for another 3 years. Thanks for everyone's support and I hope to help grow this great family sport.

There was several Rule, Bylaw & Specification changes that were voted on in Wausau.

PRC 1

Rule 12; Section C Dress code

To allow tank tops or sleeveless shirts at WT.

FAILED

PRC 2

Rule 2; Section C - Painting Stakes

This rule change would allow White chalk to be used to color Stakes. **PASSED**

PRC 3

Section F - Elder section and to add an 80 yr old **FAILED**

PBC 1

Article V : Officers

Section 6: Eligibility of Officers

This added verbiage to limit the office of President to no more than 3 full terms, no matter when served. (9 years). **PASSED**

PBC 2

Article III: Membership

Section 3 - This would change the Adult membership dues from \$25 to \$35 dollars and increase the amount for the World Tournament (WT) Prize Fund from \$3 to \$5. There was discussion on this increase and it was amended to \$30 dollars with \$5 going to the WT prize fund. **PASSED**

PBC 3

Article III: Membership

Section 4

This removed the dues for Juniors and Cadets from \$5 to \$0. **PASSED**

PSC 1

IV. Specifications

I - Equipment Specifications

This changes the specification so that shoes measured more than 1 inch due to the heel calk configuration would be legal. **PASSED**

PSC 2

II -Specifications for Court Layout

Section B

Court Sanction Requirement/Specification

This would allow the courts to be at varying distances as long as the foul line is kept at the specified distance (37', 27', 20'). **PASSED**

Next year we are headed back to Kennewick, Washington for the World Tournament and will be in the new 70,000 SF convention hall that is being completed this fall. There was some discussion on where we only had 550 pitcher's signups, that we limit entries and run 2027 in one week, July 19 - 24, 2027. So we will limit entries to 576, and the tournament schedule will be high percentage pitchers M-W and Championships and lower percentage pitchers Th-Sat. The youth will pitch M-W and start at 2pm with prelims M-Tues and Championships on Wed.

We will have the opening Ceremony Saturday July 17 at 9am right before the Warmup tournament at 10am. We are also talking about a Doubles tournament later that night.

The Delegate Meeting (8am) and HOF Banquet (5pm) would be July 18, 2027. Location to be announced in the Tournament Pamphlet. This will be a significant change and so get your entry in early before the cut off. There will be a wait list created after the cut off that will be used to fill cancellations that occur.

I look forward to seeing you at the 2026 State Singles Tournament in Pocatello Saturday, August 29. Entries must be received before the Tuesday before. There will be a Warm-up Tournament Friday, August 28. Be there by 5:30pm to sign up and start pitching at 6pm. See you on the Courts!

Regional Director & HOF Reports

To all tournament directors and others involved in running tournaments.



As we all know the pegs periodically need to be checked and resolved for their height and lean. Just as a reminder, the height should be between 14 to 15 inches tall, no shorter than 14, and no taller than 15", if these are not correct please correct them.

The lean of the peg should be a 3" gap from the front side of the peg at ground level using

a plum bob and string or something with weight on the string placing it on the top of the peg and hanging down using a tape measure to measure the distance from the front of the peg to the string or point which should be at 3".

For those that do not know, the reason for the lean is to allow the horseshoe to slide down the peg to the ground rather than with the shoe rebounding off with a straight (vertical) peg.

***Tip of the Day *** If running tournaments please check at the beginning of the season the pegs and the compound in the pits for an adequate amount of compound whether it be sand, sand/dirt mixture, or clay.

2026 HOF Inductee - I have chosen to induct one person into the HOF this year during the Idaho State Singles Saturday annual meeting & potluck at Ross Park in Pocatello, Idaho. This person will be unnamed till the induction. This person has been in the game for 40+ years.

We must remember for individuals to be considered for induction into the HOF, whether male or female, they must have put in many selfless years of contributions to the game. Plus, there are different categories such as State Championships won (in the A Class only), being a pitcher, organizer, promoter, or Officer. These individuals MUST have put aside many years of their own effort and time to excel in the growth of the game.

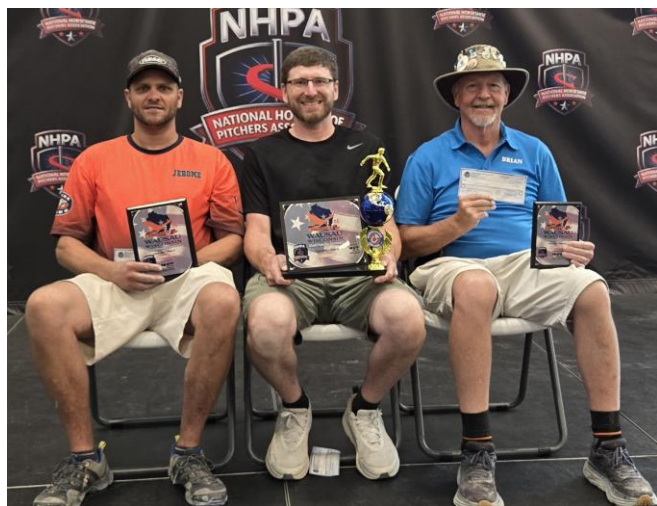

The NHPA card is a combination membership of the State Charter and the National Horseshoe Pitching Association. This membership entitles you to participate in any NHPA sanctioned tournament throughout the United States and much of Canada, wherever you meet the requirements of the event. You must pay your dues through the state charter where you maintain legal residence as determined by your legal residence.

New Members may pay next year's dues after Oct. 1st of the current year and will be eligible to participate in sanctioned events for the final 3 months of the current year, as well as all of the next year. As a member of the Idaho Charter, you can receive newsletters and a schedule of all sanctioned and some non-sanctioned tournaments in Idaho.

Your pitching stats from all sanctioned events will be forwarded to the NHPA stats called NHPA-eShoe. These stats are updated instantly when tournaments are posted to eShoe and can be accessed through the NHPA-eShoe website. You can also print your NHPA card from eShoe.
